MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Kansas Municipal Utilities Kansas Section American Water Works Association

The Kansas Municipal Utilities (KMU) and the Kansas Section American Water Works Association (KSAWWA) seek to achieve a spirit of strong cooperation between the two organizations. Our common purpose is to improve the quality of training through the joint sponsorship of large and small system operators. It is our common objective to insure that all operators may have access to the latest technologies and instruction in producing clean, safe, and sufficient water.

In order to achieve this purpose, the two organizations:

- 1. Co-sponsor training for water operators of large and small systems
- 2. Agree to hold these training sessions in the 6 different KDHE Districts of Kansas
- 3. Agree to hold these training sessions in the KMU new training facility in McPherson, KS.
 - A. Any expenses for this training that is solely related to one organization will be borne by that organization.
 - B. Funds raised as a result of special fundraisers will not be used to offset normal expenses of the training.
- 4. The KMU representative and the KsAWWA OTC Committee will determine the applicability of expenses.
- 5. KSAWWA and KMU agree that they are the official contracting parties for this training.
- 6. KSAWWA and KMU agree that once KMU's new training facility is completed a complete library of training materials held by both parties will be stored in this facility with a check out system developed for all utilities in the State of Kansas to utilize.
- The two organizations agree that they will work to continue their cooperative efforts for future endeavors.
